Aliso GSA/GSP Workshop
June 26, 2018

This workshop was very informative and well attended. The first discussion item was to go over the split water balance as requested and prepared by Ken Schmidt and P&P. There was a 3 page handout prepared by P&P that summarized the average difference of 200 AF per year more overdraft for the East side of the District compared to the whole District. There was some light discussion on this handout and further questions should be directed to Ken Schmidt and Rick Iger. The encroachment permit application to the Flood Board was next on the agenda. This permit application process has turned into a very intense and regulated process since the signing of SGMA into law. Included in this discussion was a meeting in Sacramento with the Flood Board Staff which resulted in direction and advice on submitting these permit applications. This meeting with the Flood Board Staff was very positive and their helpful advice will be incorporated on our application. The next item on the agenda was the application to the SWRCB to appropriate water from the Chowchilla bypass. This application has been completed and is under review and includes the entire Aliso Water District. This is a temporary permit to be renewed and is for 10,000 AF of water. The importance of flow meters was also discussed briefly as the SWRCB requires flow meter reading to document the pumping of the recharge water granted from their permit. The irrigated lands program will also be requesting applied water shortly. Next on the agenda was a roll out of the Aliso Water District website which Joe Hopkins walked us through. The website looked great, thanks Joe. The next item on the agenda was a presentation from Stephen Dotta with Farmland Mgt. on some recharge pond projects in progress on their property. The purpose of this recharge investigation is to determine how many acres will be necessary to recharge 10,000 AF of flood flows in approximately 110 days which is the average time the Chowchilla bypass flows every 4 years. There was also a hand out of a Draft proposal for a long term lease of property to build a recharge pond. This draft proposal is for review and discussions at a later meeting, perhaps the July 24th Aliso WD Board Meeting. Stephen had a great presentation and shared with us that after consulting with Ken Schmidt that their recharge test pond sizes need to be increased. This will be an interesting project for the Aliso Board to stay focused on. The next item on the agenda was subsidence and Joe Hopkins reviewed the importance of staying focused on this issue along

with the District's annual reading in July from the 3 bench marks in the District. The growers need to start thinking about what impacts they may have had on their infrastructure due to subsidence, if any, and report it to the District to start preparing the subsidence portion of the GSP and share information with the Delta-Mendota Basin Cooperative Committee. Lastly July is the month Aliso performs their water quality sampling so please don't forget and send a copy of your ag suitability report to both Ken Schmidt and P&P. Meeting adjourned.
